The District Attorney's Office has recently moved into their new space at the Baldwin County Courthouse!


One of the Tier One Projects of the 2018 SPLOST was the renovation of the existing courthouse. All exterior renovations and technology improvements—including teleconference equipment in the courtrooms—have been completed. The District Attorney, Solicitor, Clerk of Court, Probate and Magistrate Offices all need to expand and have better flow. The first new office has been renovated and the District Attorney's Office is now working out of the old commissioner's office. The contractor is now working on creating a better space for the Solicitor and the clients they serve.

All interior renovations are expected to be completed by the end of 2022.

Baldwin County Named A Certified Broadband Community

The Georgia Department of Community Affairs recently designated Baldwin County a Georgia Certified Broadband Ready Community. This certification signifies that a local unit of government in a community has taken steps to reduce obstacles to broadband infrastructure investment. Baldwin County is excited that Tri-County EMC and Washington EMC will provide broadband service to all its customers. The county is monitoring other broadband providers' plans to provide broadband service to the remaining unserved citizens. To receive Baldwin County's endorsement, a broadband provider must provide service to the greatest number of unserved residences and not duplicate existing service, or infringe upon the EMCs' service areas.

COVID-19 Update from Atrium Health Navicent



As of September 15, 2021, all but four of the 149 patients hospitalized with COVID-19 at Atrium Health Navicent were unvaccinated for COVID-19. 40 of the 41 patients in Intensive Care Unite were unvaccinated and 24 of the 25 patients on a ventilator were unvaccinated.

Data continues to show that vaccines save lives and help prevent serious COVID-19 infection.

Atrium Health Navicent encourages everyone aged 12 and older to get vaccinated for COVID-19. Schedule an appointment at www.CovidSafeGa.org. You can also get your vaccine at the local CVS, Walgreens, Walmart, Kroger or at the Department of Public Health. Flu shots are also now available as well.
