The CodeRED system will be used to send critical and time-sensitive communications such as:



Remembering Ms. Geneva Davis



On Saturday July 18, 2022, Geneva Bell Davis passed away peacefully at her residence surrounded by family. Family and friends remembered Davis as "a pioneer" and "kind and gentle." Geneva Bell Davis was 95. The funeral for Geneva Bell Davis was held at Trinity CME on North Wilkinson Street and internment at Baldwin Memorial Gardens on Wednesday, July 22, 2022.

Davis, the first female commissioner, first began representing District 1 in 2000 following the death of her husband, Oscar Davis, who had previously represented the district since 1985.

Geneva Davis then won two full terms (2000 and 2004)

The daughter of Oscar and Geneva Davis, Emily C. Davis, then ran and was elected in 2008. She was re-elected in 2012, 2016 and 2020. A member of the Davis family has represented District 1 for going on 40 years.

Commissioner Emily C. Davis stated, "Your words have comforted us, your support has strengthened us, and your love has sustained us. We extend our deepest thanks to you for your kindness during our greatest sadness. We appreciate it more than words can express and it will always be remembered."

The Baldwin County Health Department offers no-appointment vaccinations on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. at 100 Ireland Drive in Milledgeville. Individuals can also schedule a vaccine appointment at their convenience. Please call (478) 445-4264 to schedule an appointment. Vaccine appointments can be made for first, second, or booster doses.

The CDC now recommends that anyone who has received the complete series of vaccines, whether Pfizer, Moderna, or J&J, should get a booster shot in order to increase the efficacy of vaccination.
