Short-Term Vacation Rental Ordinance Information



In 2021, Baldwin County adopted the Short-Term Vacation Rental Ordinance. Baldwin County requires short-term rental property owners to register their properties. The ordinance also requires that overnight occupancy not exceed the maximum capacity specified in the rental certificate and a rental agent who is available 24 hours a day. The ordinance states that owners will be fined for not registering the property, and licenses can be revoked for non-compliance. Storm drain pipes in the entire Allenwood subdivision are being replaced. The county is replacing cracked and narrower pipes.



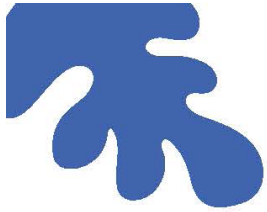
County Courthouse Renovations Continue

In accordance with O.C.G.A. § 15-6-18, the Board of Commissioners of Baldwin County declared the additional facilities for holding sessions and sittings of the Superior Court, Juvenile Court, and State Court, at the City Municipal Court and the Baldwin County Government Building, Suite 210. This need arose because the courtrooms on the fourth floor of the courthouse are being renovated.

The Walter B. Williams Recreational Center gymnasium shall continue to be an alternate court facility for sessions and sittings of Superior Court, Juvenile Court, and State Court. The courtroom at the Baldwin County Law Enforcement Facility shall continue to be an alternate court facility for Superior Court, Juvenile Court, and State Court.

Whether sessions and sittings of the Superior Court, Juvenile Court, and State Court will be held in the Courthouse or at the Walter B. Williams Recreational Center gymnasium or the courtroom at the Baldwin County Law Enforcement Center or the City Municipal Court or the Baldwin County Government Building Suite 210 shall be determined at the discretion of the Judge presiding at that session or sitting of Court, with all proper notice of such provided in advance in accordance with applicable law. The presiding Judge shall coordinate the scheduling of Court with the Sheriff. Baldwin County urges all prospective jurors and court attendees to pay close attention to the location of proceedings.
