Dividing the weighted DBE totals by the total estimate for all trades gives a base DBE availability figure for the projects anticipated during the goal-setting period. This figure is expressed as a percentage and serves as the basis for the three-year overall goal.

Base of DBE Goal: 10.88%

Step 2: Adjustments to Step 1 base figure

After calculating a base figure of the relative availability of DBEs, evidence was examined to determine what, if any, adjustment to the base figure was needed in order to arrive at the overall goal.

Not enough historical data on DBE participation is available to make an adjustment to the Step 1 base figure; therefore, Sponsor is adopting the Step 1 base figure as the overall goal for this three-year goal period.

Furthermore, there are no applicable disparity studies for the local market area or recent legal case information from the relevant jurisdictions to show evidence of barriers to entry or competitiveness of DBEs in the market area that is sufficient to warrant making an adjustment to the base goal.

Breakout of Estimated "Race and Gender Neutral" (RN) and "Race and Gender Conscious" (RC) Participation.

The Sponsor will meet the maximum feasible portion of the overall goal by using RN means of facilitating DBE participation. Each time the Sponsor submits an overall goal for review by the FAA, the Sponsor will also submit a projection of the portion of the goal that is expected to be met through race-neutral means and the basis for that projection. This projection is subject to approval by the FAA, in conjunction with its review of the County's overall goal. The County will establish contract goals to meet any portion of an overall goal when the County does not project being able to meet goals using race-neutral means.

The Sponsor estimates that in meeting the established overall goal of 10.88% it will obtain 0.00% from RN participation and 10.88% through RC measures.

The Sponsor does not have a history of DBE participation or over-achievement of goals to reference and expects to obtain its DBE participation through the use of DBE contract goals or a conscious effort to obtain DBE participation. Therefore, the entire goal of 10.88% is to be obtained through race-conscious participation.

Sponsor will adjust the estimated breakout of RN and RC DBE participation as needed to reflect actual DBE participation and track and report RN and RC participation separately. For reporting purposes, RN DBE participation includes, but is not necessarily limited to the following: DBE participation through a prime contract obtained through customary competitive procurement procedures; DBE participation through a subcontract on a prime contract that does not carry a DBE goal, DBE participation on a prime contract exceeding a contract goal, and DBE

participation through a subcontract from a prime contractor that did not consider a firm's DBE status in making the award.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Consultation:

In establishing the overall goal, Sponsor provided for consultation and publication. This process included consultation with minority, women's, and general contractor groups, community organizations, and other officials or organizations which could be expected to have information concerning the availability of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged businesses, the effects of discrimination on opportunities for DBEs, and the Sponsor's efforts to establish a level playing field for the participation of DBEs. The consultation included a scheduled, direct, interactive exchange with as many interested stakeholders as possible focused on obtaining information relevant to the goal setting process and was conducted before—the goal methodology was submitted to the operating administration for review. Details of the consultation are as follows.

The Sponsor submits its overall goal for FY 2024 – FY 2026 to the FAA in September 2023, for their consideration and approval. Before establishing the overall goal each year, the Sponsor has consulted with the stakeholders listed below, to obtain information concerning the availability of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged businesses and the effects of discrimination on opportunities for DBEs. The Sponsor's efforts are to establish a level playing field for the participation of DBEs. Following this consultation, the Sponsor has published a notice of the proposed overall goal, informing the public that the proposed goal and its rationale are available for inspection during normal business hours at the airport for 30 days following the date of the notice, and informing the public that the Sponsor and FAA will accept comments on the goals for 30 days from the date of the notice. This information was published on the FAA website and made available to the Office of Minority Business Development Agency in the State of Georgia. The notice will include the Sponsor's and FAA's addresses to which comments may be sent. The overall goal submission to the FAA will include a summary of information and comments received during this public participation process and the Sponsor's responses. We will begin using our overall goal on October 1 of each year unless we have received other instructions from DOT. Stakeholder consultation discussions were held with the following agencies and persons on September 06, 2023, at approximately 2:00 pm EDT, with no comments received.
