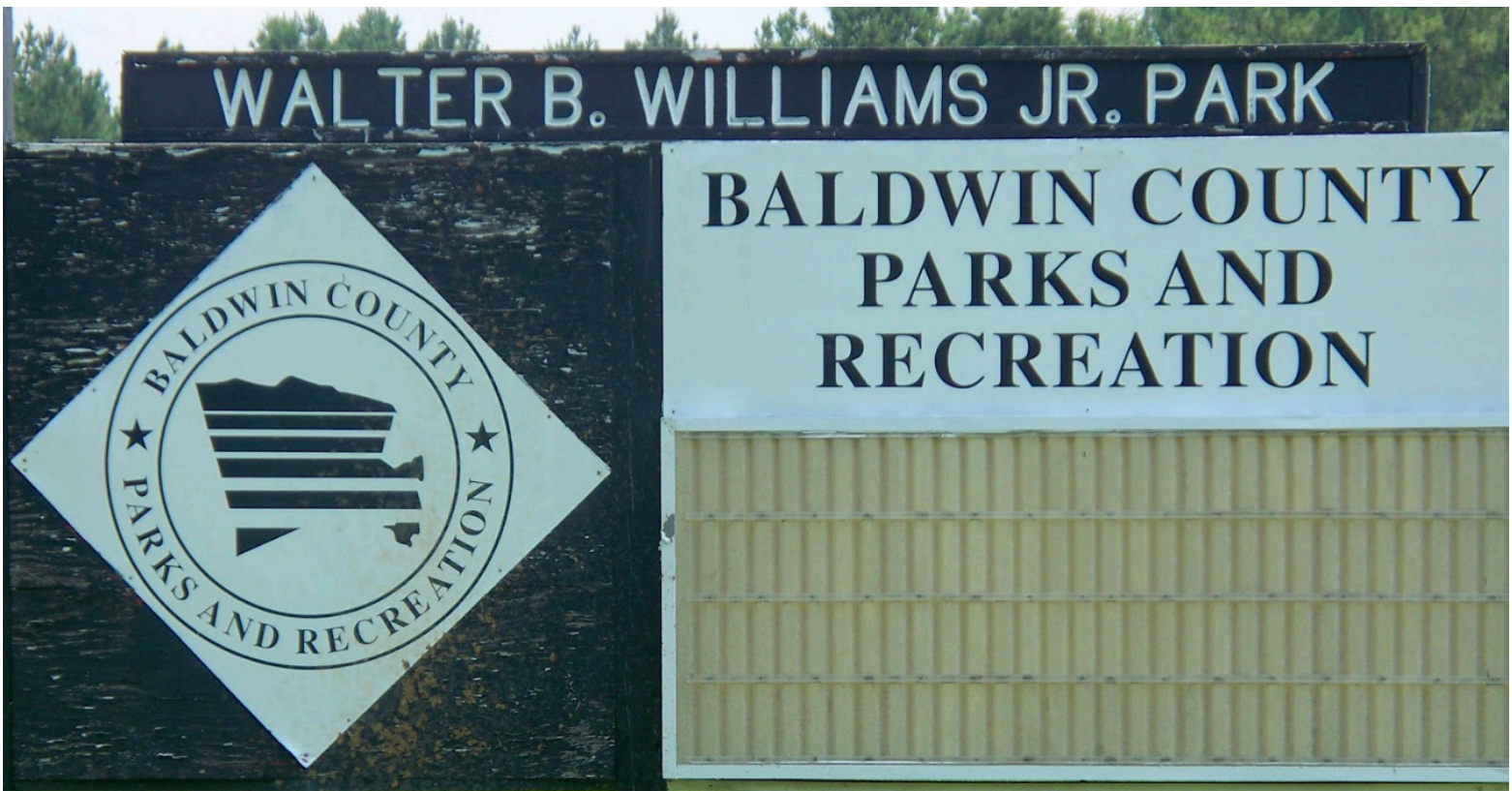

Please see the following information regarding the benefits of multi-use, or shared paths, from the Center for Disease Control. Shared use paths provide desirable space for physical activity, which in turn can reduce medical costs and prevent or decrease some types of chronic illnesses. Shared use paths can also provide mental health benefits by providing a place to exercise, which has been linked to decreasing mental health conditions such as depression and anxiety. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends 150 minutes of medium intensity exercise per week as regular physical activity. Based on data from the CDC, inactive individuals (exercising for less than ten minutes weekly) spend an estimated \$1,313 more on average in annual health care expenditures as compared to an active individual (exercising for 150+ minutes weekly). Shared use paths play an important role in providing an accessible route for people to walk, run, and bike, and offer a safe location for the elderly and disabled to exercise as well.
