

County to Submit Urban Redevelopment Plan



The Baldwin County Urban Redevelopment Plan encourages involvement of private enterprises, nonprofit organizations and Baldwin County partnerships to redevelop neglected areas of the community. The plan outlines the strategies and grants that Baldwin County will pursue. The plan guides investments in infrastructure to support redevelopment, which hopefully will achieve optimum economic and aesthetic results. This plan allows the public to know what is being planned for the redevelopment area as well.

A public hearing was held to discuss the plan on June 18th, 2024. The recommended changes have been incorporated and the Board of Commissioners will vote to adopt the plan and submit it to the Department of Community Affairs on July 2, 2024 at 6:00 p.m.

Road Paving Season Almost Here

Road paving season is almost here! Baldwin County staff and contractors are busy preparing road bases for the upcoming paving season. Bids will be opened on July 15, 2024.

Animal Control Building Improvements

Baldwin County staff has made improvements to the Animal Control building by adding an air return system in the animal rooms. The air return system pulls air out of the rooms, vastly improving the smell. These work in conjunction with the exhaust fans that were installed when the shelter was repurposed.

Additionally, staff removed the old freezer from the old jail kitchen to make room for an upgraded commercial dryer. The old jail kitchen is now the animal control laundry room. A mini-split air conditioning system will be installed in the laundry room as well.



Emergency Services Building Repaired



On Sunday, March 26, 2023 in the early morning hours, a tornado ripped through Milledgeville causing extensive damage to homes and businesses. Baldwin County was not spared. The Emergency Services Building on Orchard Hill Road suffered significant damage. After dealing with contractors, adjusters and insurance companies, the work began in the fall of 2023. Other items ordered had very long lead times. The roof, one broken window, the shed, and flooring which suffered water damage, were replaced. Brick work that was damaged was repaired by county staff.
