# OneGeorgia Authority Awards \$2 Million Rural Workforce Housing Grant to Baldwin County

The OneGeorgia Authority has awarded a \$2,208,899 Rural Workforce Housing Grant to Baldwin County. Official notification from the Georgia Department of Community Affairs was received on Friday, March 27th. The commissioners still need to decide to accept the grant.

This grant will support a new condominium development aimed at providing affordable housing for the local workforce on Frazier Drive, located on the south side of the county. The development will feature 123 townhouse-style condominiums.

County Manager Tobar stated, “The county and private sector have invested millions of dollars on the south side of the county. This particular area, east of Vinson Highway and known as Sunset Heights, has seen the bulk of the housing investment so far. Over 70 houses have been rehabilitated and all are occupied. All the sewer and water lines have been replaced as well. As has been the case across the country, when the government shows its commitment to a neighborhood, citizens and the private sector notice, and private investment follows. Homeowners help make neighborhoods safer and stronger. It is exciting to see the south side of the county revitalized.”

County Manager Carlos Tobar added, “We thank the greatest Governor in the United States, Brian Kemp, for recognizing the State of Georgia needs to facilitate the creation of affordable housing options for all the businesses coming to or expanding in Georgia. Instead of just talking about the issue, Governor Kemp has produced a creative model, along with state funds, to meet this need. Baldwin County is grateful for this infrastructure grant that will help create these affordable homes in our community. I anticipate that many first-time home buyers currently living and/or working in Baldwin County will take advantage of the opportunity.”

Baldwin County employees will have first priority to purchase units, followed by city employees, college employees and other Baldwin County workers.

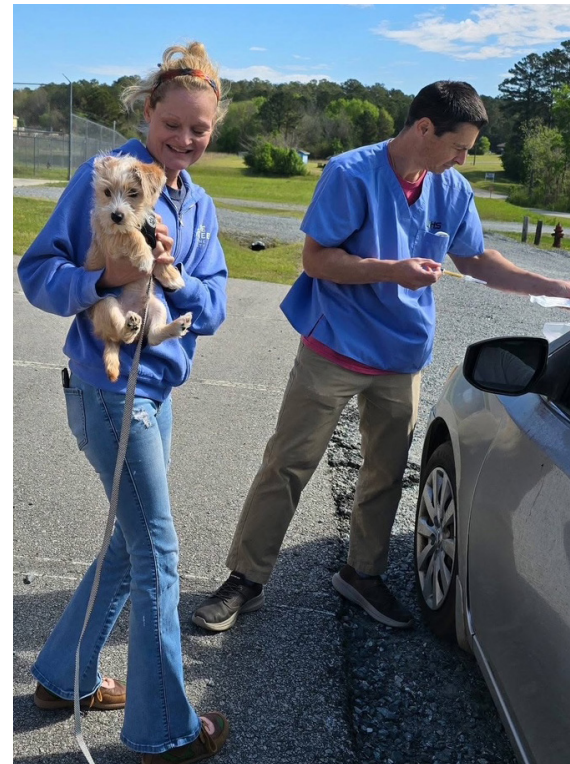
# Savannah State University Students Visit Baldwin County Emergency Management



Baldwin County Emergency Management recently hosted a group of students from Savannah State University for an advanced field training off-campus exercise. Students from a Homeland Security and Emergency Management class were greeted by the Director of the Baldwin County EMA Wayne Johnson. He presented an operations overview of how Baldwin County prepares, responds, mitigates, recovers, prevents, and manages emergency and disaster scenarios. The students also received a historical and technical overview of the Lake Sinclair Dam, which is also a fully operating hydroelectric dam managed and operated by Georgia Power. Georgia Power Engineers took the students on a full tour of the interior workings of the Lake Sinclair Hydro-Electric Generating facilities.

The students were accompanied by Professors Roy Ward and Marion Bell.
