MINOR BUFFER DISTURBANCE AUTHORIZATION APPLICATION **\$25.00 FEE**

Any property owner, representative, agent of the owner, or contractor wishing to enter or cross the twenty-five (25) foot buffer zone to construct or enlarge seawalls, docks or boat lifts shall be responsible for maintaining the buffer zone according to the standards set by the Georgia Power Company, the Georgia Water & Soil Conservation Commission (GWSWC), and the Baldwin County Local Issuing Authority (LIA).

Provisions Shall Be Made to maintain "Best Management Practices" as set by the GSWCC during the entire land disturbance activity from the beginning to the final inspection at which time permanent vegetation shall be in place at the site.

It Shall Be Prohibited And Unlawful within the twenty-five (25) foot buffer to remove trees, grade to the bare ground (except shaping and filling at the shoreline for seawall construction), remove embedded stone boulders, or any other land disturbance activity that will upset the natural balance within this buffer zone.

Application is hereby made for a "Minor" Buffer Disturbance Authorization to enter, cross or work in the twenty-five (25) foot established buffer zone.
