POSITION OVERVIEW

The Transit Bus Driver is responsible for operating a transit bus safely and efficiently along designated routes to transport passengers to and from their destinations. This role requires a strong commitment to safety, excellent customer service skills, and the ability to follow schedules while maintaining a professional and courteous attitude.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operate a transit bus in compliance with traffic laws, safety regulations, and company policies.
- Follow assigned routes and schedules while ensuring on-time performance.
- Safely load, secure, and unload passengers, including those with disabilities, using accessibility equipment when needed.
- Provide courteous and helpful assistance to passengers with questions regarding routes, schedules, and fares.
- Monitor passenger activity to ensure a safe and orderly environment on the bus.
- Perform daily pre-trip and post-trip inspections of the vehicle to ensure proper functioning.
- Report any accidents, incidents, or mechanical issues promptly to dispatch or supervisors.
- Maintain accurate records such as ridership counts, fare collections, and inspection logs.
- Adhere to all safety, security, and emergency procedures.
- Represent the transit agency in a professional and respectful manner at all times.

QUALIFICATIONS

- High school diploma or equivalent required.
- Clean driving record.
- Previous experience in commercial or passenger transportation preferred.
- Strong knowledge of traffic laws, defensive driving techniques, and vehicle operation.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to remain calm and professional in stressful or emergency situations.
- Physical ability to sit for extended periods, assist passengers, and perform bus inspections.
- Flexibility to work various shifts, including evenings, weekends, and holidays.

WORKING CONDITIONS

- Work performed primarily in a transit bus with exposure to traffic, weather conditions, and varying passenger behaviors.
- Requires extended periods of sitting, as well as occasional bending, reaching, and assisting passengers.
- May require overtime, split shifts, or rotating schedules.
