The Harrisburg Park Splash Pad will soon be ready for summer fun! The new splash pad will be close to 1,300 feet and is located at 237 Harrisburg Road SW, Milledgeville GA 31061.

The splash pad will be an outdoor recreation area that will allow children to play with water featuring spray nozzles coming out of the ground and shower attachments that release water from above. It is a safe way to introduce young children to water before learning how to swim in a pool or a larger body of water.

It will also be handicap accessible. The splash pad will be open in early July. Stay tuned for more details!

Help Our First Responders Locate Homes



First Responders working various neighborhoods have shared that many residents have numbers on their mailboxes, but they are fading or falling off and need to be replaced. Some numbers are obscured by vegetation (bushes, trees, etc.). Others do not have a post with a number at their driveway entrances. You want your First Responders to be able to find you when time is of the essence. Here are some things to consider:

- The mailbox (or driveway entrance) is a great location for visible (reflective) house numbers. Place on both sides of the mailbox or post if you live on a two-way road.
- Make sure that the numbers can be easily seen both during the day and at night. This helps greatly as they are navigating their way through a neighborhood trying to find a specific address.
- Also, consider having numbers on the house itself near the main entry/porch so that First Responders can readily identify your house. These numbers should be visible from the street during the day and at night. Be sure that the color of your numbers contrasts with your home's color, and that lights do not cause glare or reflections that make the numbers hard to read.

These are easy, inexpensive fixes that can ultimately help First Responders get to you quickly in an emergency situation.

Milledgeville Baldwin County Emergency Management encourages you to take action and register your cell phone for this service and verify your home location to receive targeted notifications that directly impact your home or business.

The CodeRED system will be used to send critical and time-sensitive communications such as:

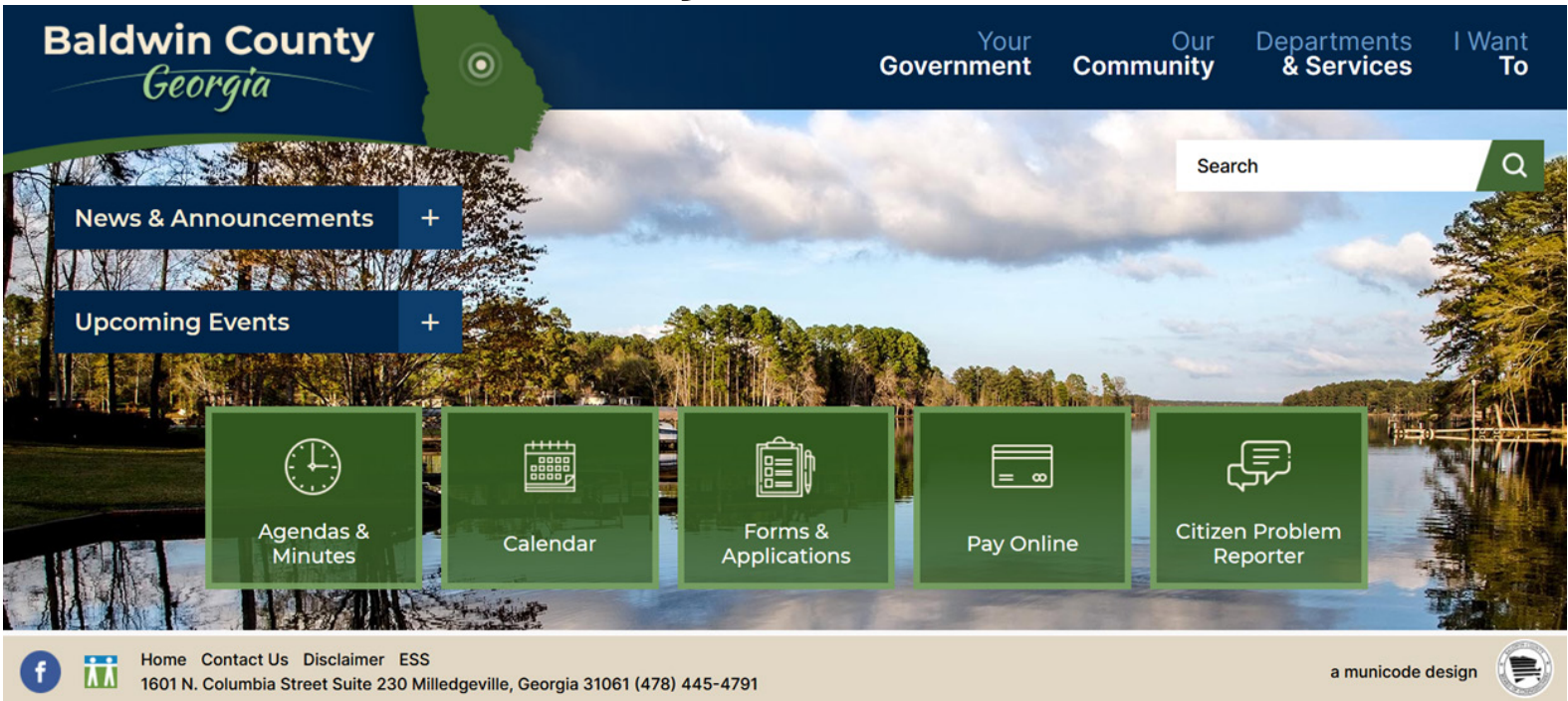
- Missing Persons/Children
