Representatives with AUC Group, headquartered in Houston, Texas, made a presentation concerning wastewater treatment plants at the Sibley-Smith Mega Industrial Park. Representatives stated the company has both short-and long-term leasing arrangements, as well as lease to own options, and installment sale programs.
