A Joint Meeting of the Baldwin County Commissioners and the Mayor and Council of the City of Milledgeville was held Thursday, June 28, 2018 at 5:15 p.m. City Hall – Executive Chambers, 119 East Hancock Street, Milledgeville, Georgia with Chair Tommy French presiding.

Call to Order

Chair Tommy French called the County's meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. and stated that a quorum of the County Commission is present.

Mayor Pro Tem Steve Chambers called the City Work Session to order at 5:15 p.m. Clerk Bo Danuser called the roll and indicated a quorum for the City is present.

T-SPLOST

Chair Tommy French stated the purpose of this joint meeting is to discuss a list of potential projects for the proposed Transportation Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (T-SPLOST). He asked County Manager Carlos Tobar to present information.

Mr. Tobar stated that he had met with City Manager Barry Jarrett to discuss the proposed T-SLOST projects, estimated revenue and proposed distribution of T-SPLOST proceeds. Mr. Tobar presented a timeline for the T-SPLOST. He stated that an intergovernmental Agreement should be developed and approved by both the City and County no later than 2:00 p.m. July 31, 2018 in order for the County to adopt a Resolution Calling for the Referendum. He stated the Call for the Election must be delivered to Election Superintendent Todd Blackwell by 2:00 p.m., July 31st for legal publication on August 3, 2018.

After discussion, elected officials of both bodies agreed they should proceed with the process for the imposition of a T-SPLOST.

Commissioner Henry Craig made a motion for County Manager Tobar and City Manager Jarrett to meet no later than July 13, 2018 to prepare a list of projects for the T-SPLOST. Commissioner Sammy Hall seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Councilmember Walter Reynolds made a motion that City and County Managers meet to develop the list of T-SPLOST projects. Councilmember Jeanette Walden seconded the motion. The Clerk called roll for the vote and it passed unanimously.

City and County Managers agreed to prepare project lists for inclusion in the Intergovernmental Agreement no later than July 13, 2018. The County will present the Agreement for approval at its Regular Meeting to be held July 17, 2018 with the City to approve the Agreement as well by 2:00 p.m. July 31, 2018.

Adjournment

Commissioner Henry Craig made a motion to adjourn the Joint Meeting. Commissioner Sammy Hall seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Councilmember Walter Reynolds made a motion to adjourn the City Work Session. Councilmember Jeanette Walden seconded the motion. The Clerk called roll for the vote and it passed unanimously
