Call to Order

Chair Tommy French called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

Executive Session

Commissioner Emily C. Davis made a motion to adjourn into Executive Session at 4:02 p.m. for the purpose of discussing potential litigation. Commissioner Sammy Hall seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Regular Meeting

Commissioner Sammy Hall made a motion for the County Manager to send a letter to the City of Milledgeville informing them that the county will discontinue funding the city library effective July 1, 2019, and cease Animal Control Operations, to comply with state law, if a Service Delivery Strategy Agreement with the City of Milledgeville is not in place by July 1, 2019. Commissioner John Westmoreland seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Commissioner Emily C. Davis requested that department heads, elected and appointed officials be afforded the opportunity to present their budgets to the commissioners.
