Sealed bids will be received until 2:00 pm EST, Friday, March 8, 2019, and then publicly opened and read in the Commissioners Room, located at 121 N. Wilkinson Street, Suite 314, Milledgeville, Georgia for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment and performing all work necessary to complete the project.

The project generally consists of clearing, grading, placing embankment, installation of storm sewers, asphalt paving, airfield lighting and erosion control.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in the amount of five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid. The bid guaranty may be by certified check or bid bond made payable to the Baldwin County Board of Commissioners.

Bids may be held by the Baldwin County Board of Commissioners for a period not to exceed 120 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

The right is reserved, as the Baldwin County Board of Commissioners may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bids received.

This project is subject to the requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act (29 CFR Part 5), as amended. The Contractor is required to comply with wage and labor provisions and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor.

Bidders shall inform themselves concerning Georgia laws and comply with same.
