Update on GIS Projects

GIS Specialist Ernie Smith presented a power point presentation on the Aerial Photography / GIS projects. Mr. Smith presented information on the Light Detection and Ranging (LiDAR) program. He stated this program generates mass points coordination with various values, i.e. multi- dimensional such as height and width. He discussed the many ways the data is useful to all County departments, voter registration, airport, 911, fire, sheriff's department and tax assessor's office. There is greater resolution in the photography which provides better information on the maps. The utility mapping has started identifying waterlines to tanks and hydrants and fire hydrant inventory. He stated the road centerline capability is extremely important in parcel accuracy, delineation of surface features, wetlands, land use, and many other invaluable functions.
